Marrow Donor Cheek-Swab Testing
Tuesday, March 27th
7:00 AM to 7:00 PM
In the Wintergarden at PPG Place
at Stanwix & 4th Avenue, Downtown

It takes just minutes to sign up and be tested to be a potential stem cell donor. Your information will be entered into the National Bone Marrow Registry where our Amy and all the other Amy's around the world search for a lifesaving donor match. Read the FAQ pages on our website to learn more.

- The test consists of a **simple cheek-swab** sample taken with a cotton swab.
- You must be generally healthy and **between the ages of 18 and 60** years old.
- Download and fill out the donor consent form in advance to save time at the drive.
- **This is not a blood test.** You can register even if you just donated blood.
- **You pay nothing.** All fees are covered by Amy's Army and the HLA Registry.

Although the testing costs of \$70/person are covered, Amy's Army continues to fundraise to offset these costs. You can help by sending a contribution to:
